Curriculum

Trips

A quick reminder:

Homework

See below for the rotation of homework for this term. In addition to this, all children are to bring their reading records in to school every Monday to be checked. These need to have a record of reading which should be filled in for at least 5 days of every week. Your child can fill it in and you can initial it or sign it – this is fine. They should be reading for at least 15 minutes a day at this age - this will support them through their school career and future life! If your child is a fluent reader, it is important that you still listen to them read at least once a week. If your child is a reluctant reader, you can alternate listening to them read with you reading to them - this is also very beneficial. Because this is so very important, if your child doesn't bring in their reading record, we will be keeping them in at break time on Mondays to read.

Please also remember to use the Accelerated Reader and Times Tables Rock Stars computer programs as these are used to supplement your child's learning at school and at home. The more these sites are used, the better the progress of your children!
