Catchment area

Majority of pupils live within 2 miles and most staff live within 5 miles. Due to change to primary staus, the catchment has changed over the next few years to include more pupils from north of the A316. Too early to see if this results in more pupil journeys by car, but will endeavour to make parents and carers aware of the H37 bus which runs through both neighbourhoods. Catchment area has become smaller and more children walk rather than use bike.

Expansion plans

School recently expanded from 3FE junior to 2FE primary. All pupils now on Winchester Road site adjacent to A316 red route into London. Possible feeder nursery for Sept 2016, not yet approved.

Engineering measures

Recently the ped gates on Winchester Rd were widened to allow for the increase in pupils and this was funded by the school. Only 5 parking permits are allowed for staff as part of our planning permission. School responded to consultation to increase pedestrian access on Winchester Rd and the work has now been completed.
